HERE'S A TAX TIP FOR YOU

If you have had occasion to take a personal leave which required you to pay the cost of a substitute, whether one was needed or not, you can deduct this as an employment expense on your income tax form. All you have to do is visit <u>www.google.ca</u>: type in "T2200 Canada" and download the form. Send the completed form to Theresa Reich, Controller with Edmonton Catholic District for verification, and enter the expense on your tax return at "Line 229 -Other employment expenses". The amount is actually on your December pay stub under "Deductions year to date". Your income is reduced by that amount.
