MOTION 503

Teachers and schools must be held accountable, but is standardized testing the way to do it? Not only do these tests place an undeserved and unnecessary pressure on students, they also provide only a small snapshot of what students, teachers, and schools are doing.

"Because students are not randomly assigned to schools and because schools have little or no control over the majority of factors, any attempt to place blame for poor test performance on the schools alone without giving proper consideration to each of these factors is problematic at best and misleading at worst." Ranking schools or jurisdictions based on test results negatively affects students and school communities.*
