All you have to do is visit <u>www.google.ca</u>: type in "T2200 Canada" and download the form. Send the completed form to Theresa Reich, Controller with Edmonton Catholic District for verification, and enter the expense on your tax return at "Line 229 - Other employment expenses". The amount is actually on your December pay information under "Deductions year to date". Your income is reduced by that amount. *~Kathy Maclsaac*, Executive Director
