AMAZING EFFORTS IN 21ST CENTURY LEARNING

How can we be not amazed by the quality of teaching and dedication of teachers in our Local?

With the increasing workloads and demands on our time, so many continue to take on responsibilities that they believe will benefit children. The following tries to capture one such project and I hope that by including the names of the "leads" involved, we will all be impressed and thankful for their efforts. Last week I attended, along with one group of the lead teachers and administrators, the year end wrap-up of the first year of the AISI Inquiry's 21st Century Learning project.

For the longest time AISI has been one of those frustrating four letter words that has consultants and school districts scrambling every three years to make every effort to keep the momentum going. In year one of this inquiry project, lead teachers were asked to build the foundations and understanding of how inquiry-based learning strategies are a catalyst for 21st century learning goals. Those lead teachers worked at internalizing these understandings by implementing inquiry-based strategies and methods in their classrooms within a focused subject area.

Along with the listing of teams, we acknowledge the work of our consultant teachers: Carol Durnford (Science), Heidi Dempsey (Social Studies) and Joe Estephan (Mathematics).
