# **PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE** Greetings everyone!

I hope this past Easter weekend was joyful for us all. The Lenten journey every year gives us Catholic teachers a special lens for viewing our lives and our work. It is also the time of the year when staffing is uppermost in our minds and for our temporary contract folks it is a time of concern and worry about the coming year. For many, there is the knowledge that, as of the end of June, they will have no position for September. I have the greatest admiration for these teachers who continue to give of their time and talent every day and give their best to the task at hand and to the children they serve! To teachers who are looking for a new challenge, our hats are off to you as you step into the world of change and to those who will have to be placed on priority placement lists, we hope that the new year with new communities will be life giving.

In his first reflection on Lent this year, Father Ron Rolheiser introduced us to the idea of "liminal space". The term refers to special times in our lives when our "normal situation is uprooted so that it is possible to plant new roots and take up life in a whole new way." His examples of these times are wide ranging from health concerns including imminent death, to losing friends and lovers, losing positions and jobs along with the associated status, to being betrayed, humiliated and rejected. I am willing to bet that each of us falls into one or more of these few categories and we are challenged to face them head on and come out better than when the "space" began to unfold. If we are able to bathe these experiences with our faith story, we can find solace that our Teacher faced this liminal space in one shot and experienced all the above and more on his Holy Thursday and Good Friday!

Father Ron goes on to say there is never a good time to receive such news and we know that the human reactions of anger, sadness, disappointment and regret are perfectly normal---which is why we resist such news in powerful ways. In community this is a perfect time for us to be aware of our fellow staff members and friends who are receiving unwanted news and give them the gift of time, a listening ear and words of encouragement that all will be well.

You teachers of this local are an incredible lot who are nearing the end of another wonderful year of service. You have been an amazing tribute to our profession and have given amazing service to fellow teachers through your support of this local. I encourage you take special care of each other at this stressful time of year and take every opportunity over the next couple of weeks to have your voice heard in the upcoming provincial election. In a couple of weeks we will have a good idea of what the next four years will look like. We are blessed to be able to do the work we do.
